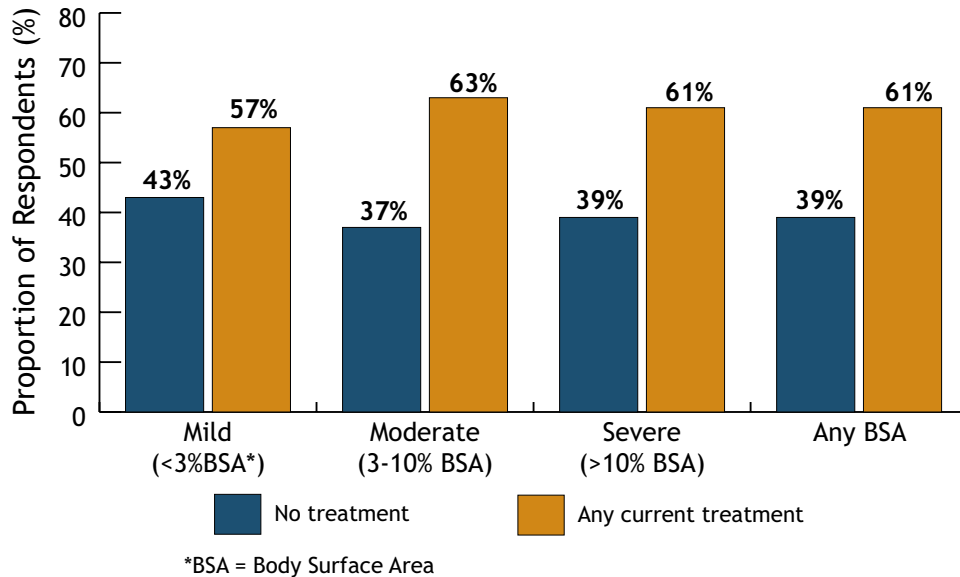


The National Psoriasis Foundation has been conducting semiannual surveys since 2003 to understand psoriasis disease burden and treatment patterns. Six rounds of surveys from Spring 2003 through Fall 2005 were combined to look at overall treatment patterns.

- Up to 40% of patients with moderate to severe psoriasis are not currently receiving treatment.

- As many as 57% of patients with severe psoriasis are not receiving treatment in accordance with accepted therapy guidelines.
