



About the National Psoriasis Foundation Survey Panel

The National Psoriasis Foundation conducts survey panels twice each year to understand the experiences and opinions of people with psoriasis and psoriatic arthritis. These surveys help the Foundation gain awareness and document the impact of these diseases. This information is used to shape programs that meet the needs of the psoriasis community and to determine the need for additional research. The survey findings used to support the Psoriatic Arthritis Total approach to Health (PATH) program were sponsored by Abbott and reported on responses from 405 people with psoriasis and psoriatic arthritis, one in three of whom had been diagnosed with psoriatic arthritis (n=165).
